Comments

Other risks that were identified: Insecurity, COVID-19 pandemic restrictions, and civil protests and sporadic violence across the country: These risks are rated **Substantial**. During the first surge of the pandemic, a national lockdown and restrictions on movements were put in place that lasted over two months. There is a risk that a new wave of infections in the future could result in another round of lockdowns and restrictions. Additionally, there has been nation-wide protests against police brutality, some of which turned violent with many government offices

vandalized. Given that poverty, inequality and youth unemployment are the underlying motivations for protests and vandalism, the risk from future civil protests to the Program is substantial.

Perceptional and reputational risks: This risk is rated **Moderate**. The substantial increase in financing and attention to a sector that has historically been marginalized is likely to attract the attention of the media and CSOs, increasing pressure on the Government to deliver on the reform agenda. Prior shortcomings in the sector – such as the non-functionality of water supply infrastructure – have impacted public trust in what the Government can achieve and is therefore likely to adversely impact the perception of the Program's ability to deliver sustainable services.
