- The sum of \$10,000 was approved for the network. \$5000 received so far

- 1000 copies of Primer on WASH News sources in Nigeria printed and distributed to Journalists giving them news sources and aiding their ability to source relevant news.

### Challenges

- Journalists were not used to writing pro poor WASH stories. Most of the people that contributed stories were non members of the WASH media network.
- The quality of news writing also very poor, and a lot of effort was made to rewrite the stories to make them publishable.

### Achievements

- 16 WASH stories were published with this grant, two of them in audio formats.
- Several of the stories submitted were not used because they did not fulfil the criteria.
- The publication of the HANDBOOK ON WASH is a remarkable achievement as it is billed to increase the visibility of the network.
- For the remaining part of the project, it will be more fruitful to commission investigation of specific pro poor WASH issues, rather than an open invitation for submission of stories.


