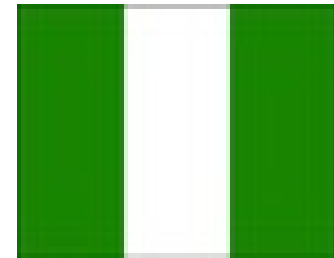

# Overview of CSO and grant process

- **Bread of Life Dev. Foundation** is an NGO primary focused on Policy advocacy for pro poor WASH programming; undertakes consultancy studies on WASH sectoral issues; implements WASH projects such as construction of sanitation facilities and promotion of hand washing campaigns; and partners with the media to popularise WASH messages
- Registered with the Corporate Affairs Commission in October 5, 2001 as an Incorporated Trustee.
- **Bread of Life Dev. Foundation** won the '*Best Water Messenger Prize*' at the 2003 World Water Forum in Japan; and Finalist of the '*Kyoto World Water Prize*' at the 2006 World Water Forum in Mexico
- In April 2008, **Bread of Life Dev. Foundation** submitted a proposal titled: **Project Reach** (*Reaching the Urban poor with Water and Sanitation services*) to the Anambra State Technical Unit, European Union Water supply and sanitation sector reform programme.
- This is a 10 month project to be implemented in 20 urban towns in Anambra state.

# Project work plan

1. Water and Sanitation survey and Poverty mapping of 20 focus Urban towns and production of a discussion report on its findings- **1<sup>st</sup> -3<sup>rd</sup> month**
2. Inauguration of 25no Water User Association at 20 focus urban towns and at state levels- **3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> month**
3. Inauguration of 25 no Water Vendors Association in 20 focus Urban towns and at state levels- **3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> month**
4. Discussion and adoption of a position paper on the Water and Sanitation survey by Water User Associations and Water Vendors Associations - **3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> month**
5. Sensitisation meetings for Water User and Water Vendors Associations in the 20 Urban communities on Urban poor WASH advocacy issues – **5<sup>th</sup>- 6<sup>th</sup> month**
6. Training workshop for Government WATSAN officials *on strategies towards Achieving the MGDs WATSAN targets in peri urban areas of Anambra* – **5<sup>th</sup> month**
7. Advocacy visits by leadership of Water Users Association and Water Vendors Association to Anambra State WATSAN agencies – **7<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> month**
8. Publication of monthly Newsletter on Project activities - **2<sup>nd</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> month**
9. Production and broadcast of a 30 minute weekly Radio Programme on Project activities – **2<sup>nd</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> month**

## Synergy with WSSSRP reform and governance objectives

1. *Project Reach* seeks to enhance integrated delivery of water supply by private sector and the government agencies to urban poor in 20 towns of Anambra state.
2. *Project Reach* seeks to build a network of water users association in Urban towns of Anambra state as a platform of promoting consumer rights and ensuring better service delivery by private and government service providers
3. *Project Reach* seeks to build a network of water vendors association in Urban towns of Anambra state as a platform of increasing their operational capacity and efficiency as well as build partnerships with Anambra State Water and Sanitation Agencies.
4. *Project Reach* seeks to develop the technical capacity of the Anambra State Government key Water and Sanitation officials for improved sectoral governance towards ensuring the delivery of MDG targets for residents of urban slums. An outcome of the project is the development of an Anambra State Urban Slum WATSAN service delivery framework.
