Daily Independent learnt that the research scheme would likewise increase access to safe and ensure adequate and sustainable water and sanitation services in Osun and five other states. The states include Anambra, Cross River, Jigawa kano and Yobe.

This, it was gathered, will be done through improved water governance and sanitation ervice delivery in urban areas.

The endeavour will also kick start the development of the Osun State Water Folicy, requiring that the BLDF carries out desk study on all reports and/or document related to Institutional framework development, while appraising assessment development; while appraising the rationale for policy development in the state. Similarly, the group will hold consultative meetings with relevant stakeholders for the purpose of enlightenment on the purpose of enlightenment of the state of the purpose of enlightenment on the purpose development of a state specific water supply and sanitation

The BLDF Project Officer, Oluwasanmi Falobi, said in a statement that, as part of the study, the NGO will review the organisational, commercial and technical structure of the state's utilities parastatals (the OSWC and OSEPA), while assessing the roles the private sector can play financial,

in financing water delivery water and sanitation services.

BLDF, he added, has formed a team of 10 experts headed by Professor Lekan Oyebande who is Chair Technical Committee of the West African Water Partnership of the Global Water Partnership

GWP) to carry out the study.
